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### LA SALLE PREP HISTORY

La Salle Prep, a Catholic co-educational college preparatory school in Milwaukie, Oregon, is one of approximately 1,600 educational institutions sponsored by the Christian Brothers. The Brothers founded La Salle in 1966.

As the mission statement directs, La Salle is especially committed to providing increased opportunities for economically disadvantaged youth. Currently 220 families, representing 35% of La Salle families, receive financial aid, with 8% below federal poverty line.

### ACCREDITATION

The school is accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools and is a member of the National Catholic Education Association.

### SCHOOL SCHEDULE

La Salle is on a semester system with seven periods scheduled daily. Three days each week class periods consist of 47 minutes. For two days each week classes meet for 85 minutes each, with each class meeting once during the two-day period. Students are required to carry no fewer than six subjects each semester. The average class size is 24 and the average teacher load is five periods. The teacher/student ratio is 18:1.
